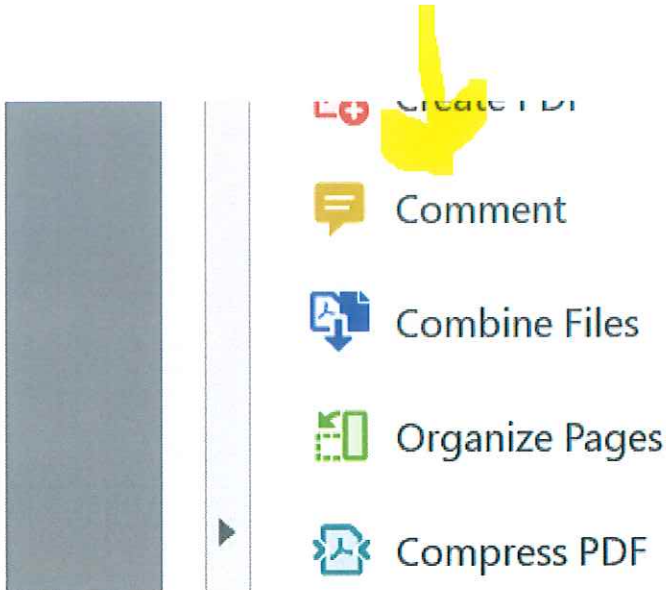


How to write in any PDF

Open up the PDF

To the right hand side of the screen click on COMMENT

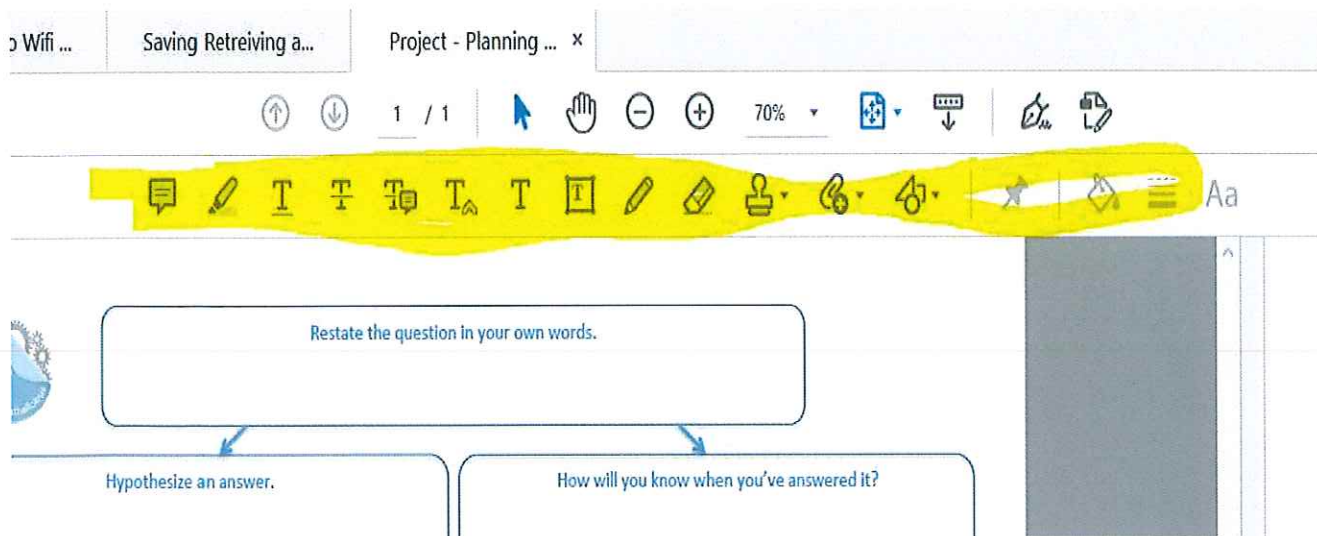


Now you have all the tools you need for you PDF

If you are connected to the internet and get a page something like this



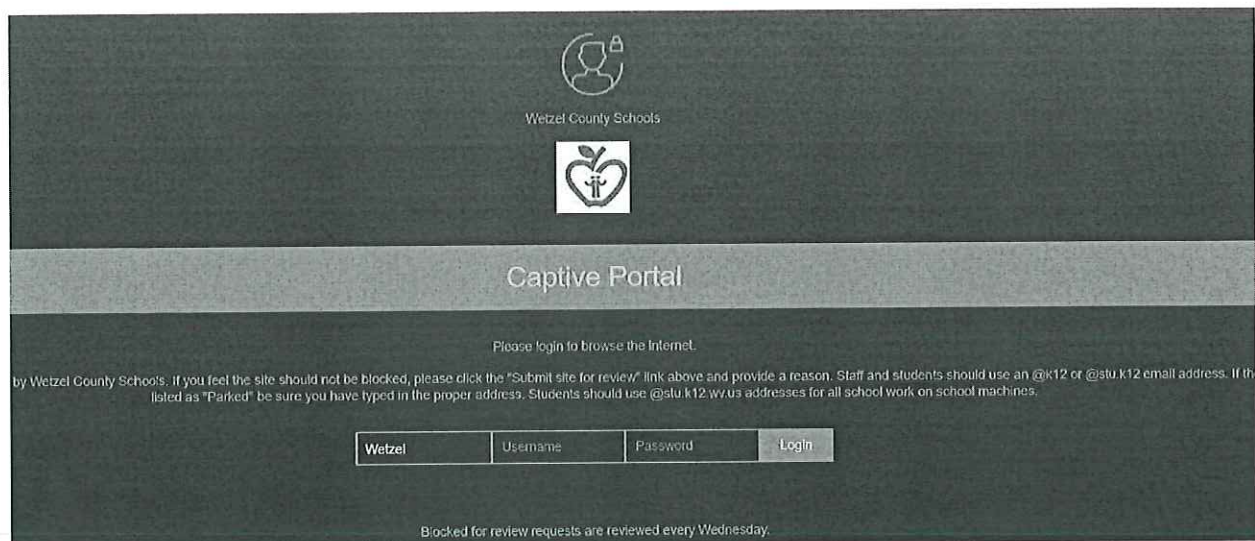

Blocked for review requests are reviewed every Wednesday.

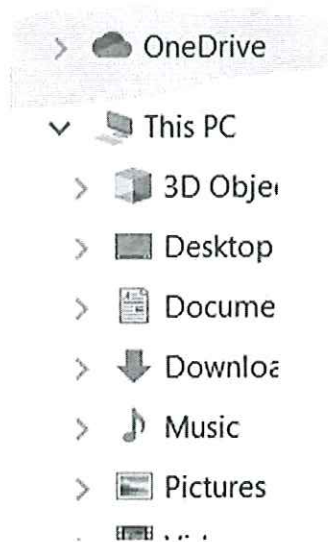
Change LOCAL to WETZEL and put in the username and password you use to log into the laptop

If you are going into Schoology and trying to upload an assignment and cannot find the assignment on OneDrive, do these steps!!!!

1. Click on the File Explorer Folder at the bottom of your laptop in the tool bar



2. Double Click on the OneDrive



3. You will now come to a screen where you will enter your email address
4. Now you will enter your password
5. Continue to hit next -- then you will say Later to set up app
6. Once you are done it will set up your OneDrive in the folder -- the new folder screen will pop up with your OneDrive folders and documents

SAVING ANYTHING TO ONEDRIVE

(Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Publisher)

Go File

SAVE AS

Click on OneDrive

If your email is not visible underneath the OneDrive

Then you are not signed

Click the SIGN IN Icon located at the top right of the screen.

Do not click on the SIGN IN in the middle of the screen—it will not log you in correctly.

You can now save to your OneDrive

To RETRIEVE your FILE

Click on the Office 365 icon on your desktop.

Scroll down to the bottom of the page. Things you have saved recently will show up there, if not click on the ONEDRIVE icon and it will take you to everything you have saved.

CONFERENCES with a Teacher

Schoology

1. Log into Schoology
2. Select your course
3. Click Conference on the left side
4. Click the name of the Conference. Your teacher must start the conference for students to be able to join.
5. Join the conference with Microphone or Listen Only (Depending on how your teacher directs you)
6. Allow the microphone access and complete the echo test.

You are now in a conference with your teacher.

Course Assignments

Assignments are graded items. Each assignment may require you to make a submission. Once you've made a submission, the instructor can grade the assignment, provide feedback, and upload a file back to you.

To submit a file to an assignment, follow these steps:

1. In the Assignment, click **Submit Assignment**.
2. Use the **Add a Comment** area for questions and concerns (optional).
3. Select one of these options:
 - **Upload**: Select a file from your computer.
 - **Create**: Create a document on the web using the text editor.
 - **Resources**: Select a file from your Resources, which can be a Google Doc if you have linked your account (See **Account Settings** for more details).
4. Click **Submit** to finish.

The tests/quizzes material is one type of online assessments for courses. These tests/quizzes can have an assortment of the following question types:

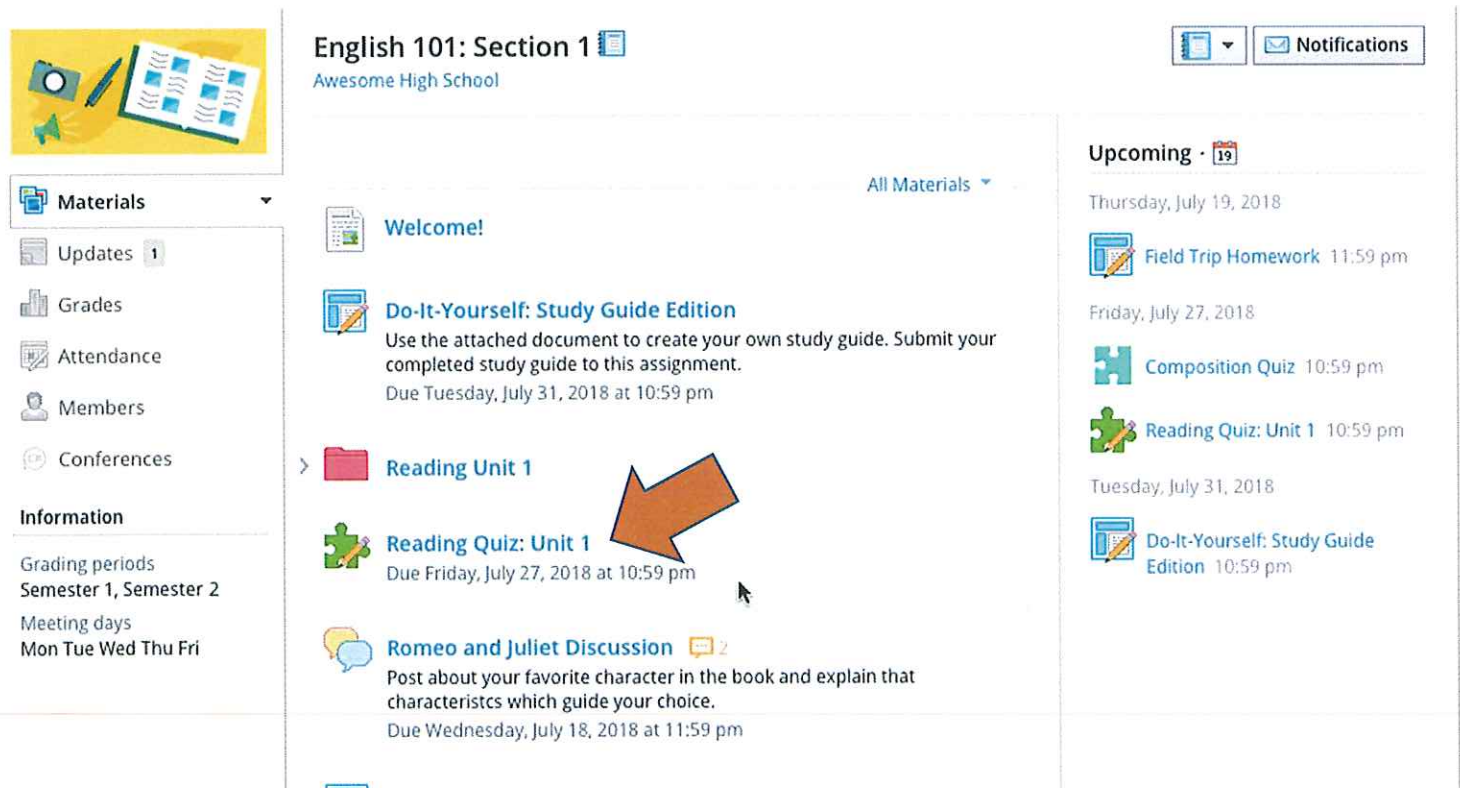
1. True/False

How do I take the Assessment?

6. Click **Yes** to submit your Assessment attempt. Click **No** if you need to continue the review of your attempt.

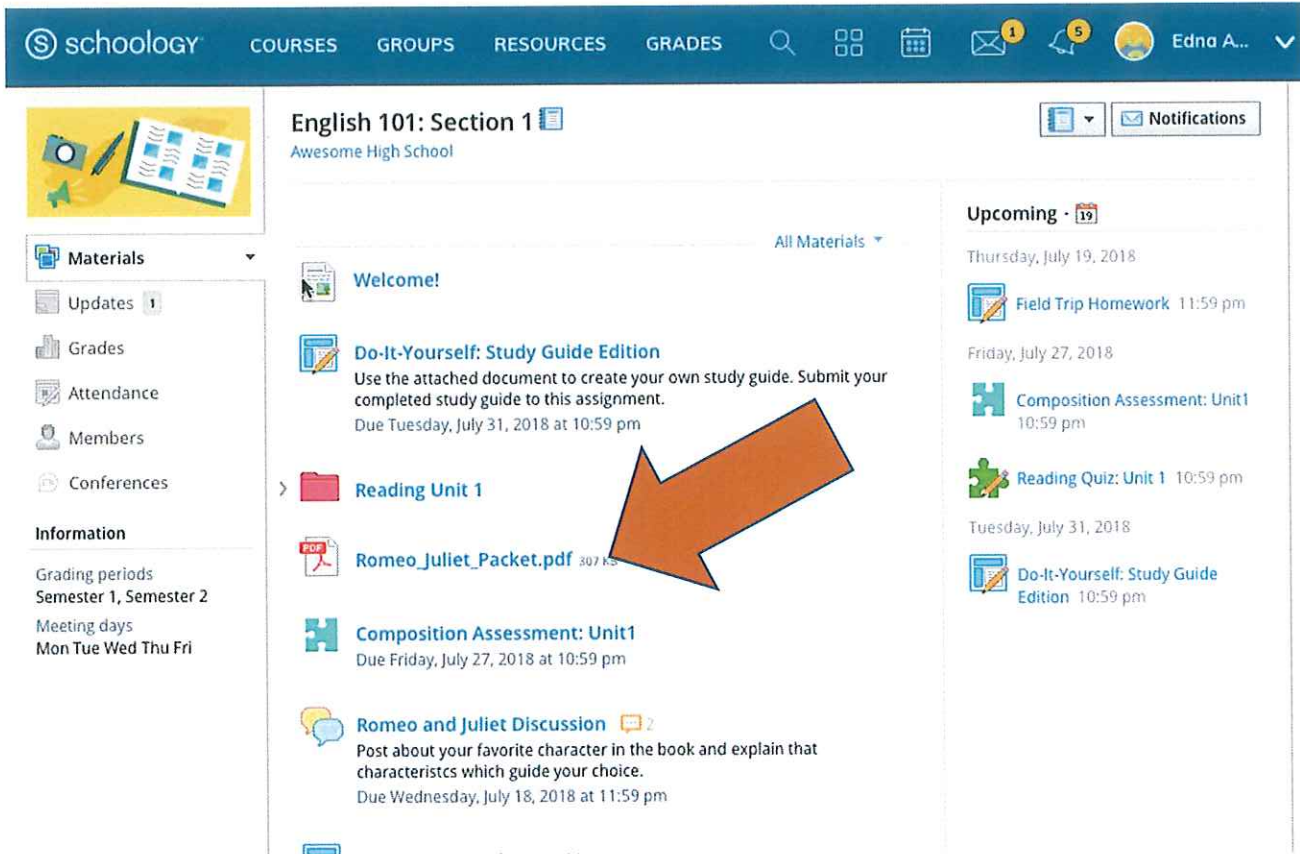

4. PDF (.pdf)

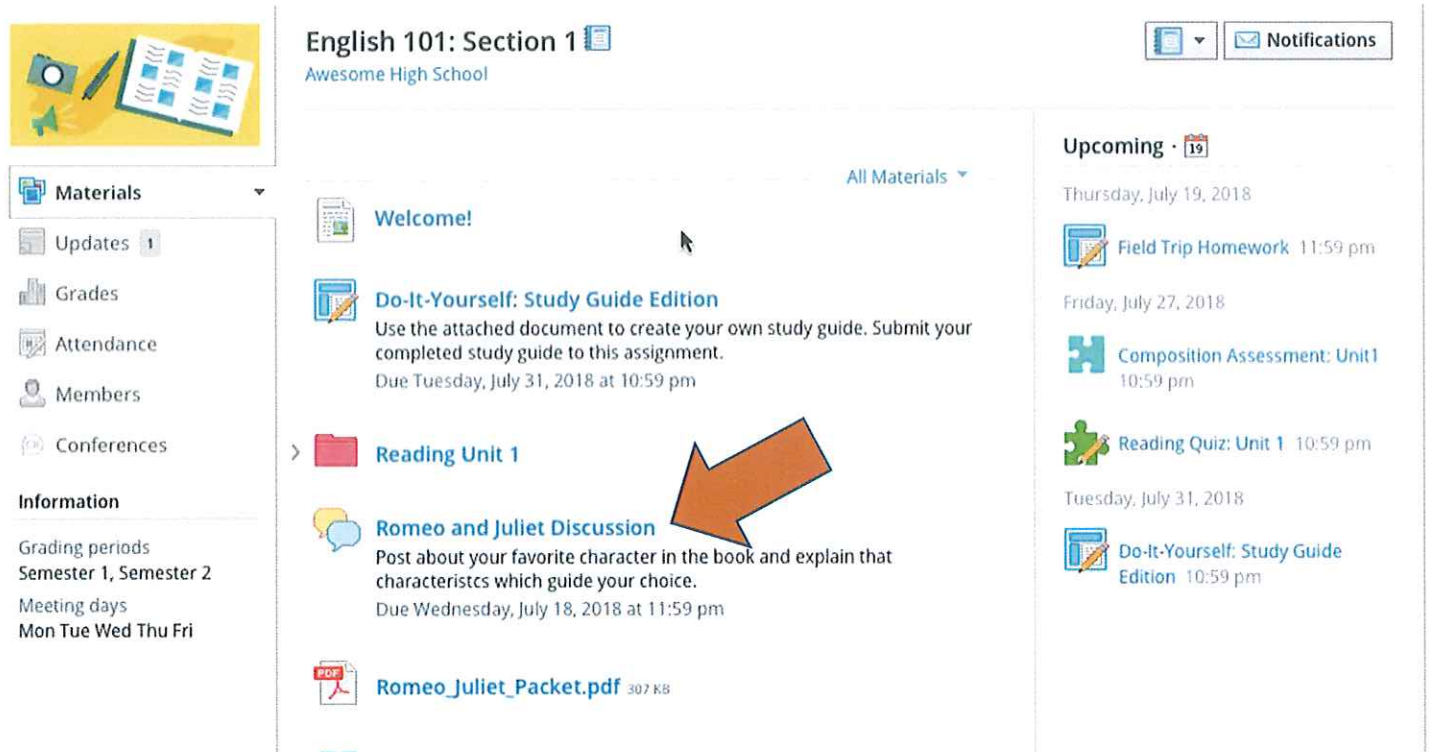
