OPENING, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE, AND INVOCATION:

This Regular Session of the Wetzel County Board of Education was called to order by the President of the Board, Mr. Michael D. Blair. Mrs. Kirk led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and Mr. Blair gave the opening Invocation.

REPORTS:

Annual Report of the Local School Improvement Council of Paden City Elementary School - Tammy D. Chambers, Principal Paden City Elementary School and LSIC Chairs:

Mrs. Chambers thanked everyone for coming and recognized the Local School Improvement Council Members present: Jeff Rexroad and Jo Anna Filliez, Service Personnel; Shawna Christner, Parent; and Elliott Kendle, Teacher and President. Mrs. Chambers announced that Wetzel County Hospital is a new Partner in Education with Paden City Elementary, and that Tad Greene will be the representative for the hospital. Mrs. Chambers provided the Board with information on the school discipline data, noting a decrease in office referrals and number of detentions, and informed the Board that enrollment is up this year. She discussed the Annual Productive and Safe Schools Report, highlighting the activities the school did to promote anti-bullying. She also provided the list of awards given out for the 2012-2013 school year, as well as the many activities the staff and students participated in.

Mrs. Chambers reviewed the WESTEST 2 results and trend data for 2012-2013. The results designated the school as a Support School. She provided the Board with various data analysis sheets, noting many students have improved. She stated they will continue working with the students, trying new strategies to increase student achievement.

Mr. Kendle reviewed the LSIC goals for Paden City Elementary School for 2012-2013 and presented the goals for the 2013-2014 school year:

- 1) Continue to update and improve the school campus, to include a safer walk route.
- 2) Support the Strategic Plan Goals and improvement of academic achievement specific to student growth.
- 3) Continue upgrading technology.

Mr. Kendle added the staff is excited about teaching and learning, and said, "their focus is on the growth of each individual child so they can grow up to become a productive part of society".

Annual Report of the Local School Improvement Council of Paden City High School-Jason P. Salva, Principal Paden City High School and LSIC Chairs:

Mr. Salva welcomed the Board and guests to the meeting. Mr. Salva stated the LSIC has met twice this year to look over the goals from last year and establish their goals for this year. He reviewed the WESTEST 2 scores and stated that Paden City High School recently received the distinction as a "WV Success School". He explained that a Success School means they are meeting their Index-based target and that a majority of its subgroups are making sufficient academic progress. He stated that the school is listed on the <u>U.S. World News and Report</u> website as being one of twenty-seven high schools in WV that was given a Bronze rating as a Best High School in the United States.

Mr. Salva recognized the Local School Improvement Council members present: Lisa Shepherd, Teacher; Mary Ferrebee, parent; and Cork Bowen, Chairman. He stated he takes pride in the fact that the school has increased in enrollment, and the daily attendance rate is the highest in the County. He reviewed the discipline data and stated the number of detentions and suspensions have declined. The staff has high expectations in the classroom. The school has set up space for the police department to be in the building for them to work in and out of throughout the day.

Mr. Salva informed the Board that he and three teachers from the school attended a READ 180 training for high schools. This is a program for struggling readers, and focuses on student weaknesses. He feels this program will bring gains in the students reading ability, which will bring gains with testing.

Mr. Salva recognized Adam Croasmun, Denton Thomas, and J.R. Powell, who were three of forty-nine students who won First Place in the Fairmont State Engineering and Science Competition 2013.

Adam Croasmun, Student Body President, Student Council President, and the Thespian Group President, spoke to the Board about the success of their musical, "You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown", which was performed in the spring of 2013. The theater group has grown from six members to nineteen members. They are looking to do another musical in January or February, 2014.

Cork Bowen spoke to the Board and stated that Paden City High School has been gaining in enrollment by 10-12% a year. He said the school's goal is to reach out to the kids that live in Paden City, that choose to attend other schools, and get them to attend school in Paden City. They are also working on how to keep the connection with the students at the grade school, and to have opportunities for those students to come to the high school, to keep the unity going. Mr. Bowen reviewed Paden City High School's LSIC goals for 2013-2014 school year:

- 1) Decrease the dropout rate
- 2) Increase enrollment
- 3) Enrich Core Curriculum by providing outside sources (i.e. partners in education, benefactors in the area)
- 4) Improve communication with the community

Mr. Bowen thanked the Board for the new stadium seating and lighting, the new surveillance cameras, and new visitors-side press box. Mr. Salva also thanked them for the paved parking lot and internet upgrades. Mr. Bowen stated they are concentrating on getting more Ipads and laptops to increase the student-to-computer ratio. Mr. Salva also said they are looking to get one more Smart board for a newly established classroom.

Mr. Blair thanked both schools for their presentations, and Mrs. Chambers for hosting the meeting.
