know all men by these presents, that we m, T. Robinson, principle, and the form of the surety, are held and firmly bound unto the Board of Education of Church District, Wetzel County, W.Va. in the just and full sum of Four Hundred and Fifteen dollars (\$415.) to the payment whereof well and truly to be made to the said Board of Education as aforesaid, we bind ourselves, our executors, administrators and assigns, jointly and severly, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this day of September, 1913.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, the above named T.L.Robinson was on the 6th, day of September, 1913, awarded the contract of painting three school houses in said Church District, for the total sum of Two Hundred and Seven dollars (\$207.)

Now therefore, if the said T.L.Robinson shall perform the said contract according to the specifications as recorded by the Secretary of said board, in his record book, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
