The Condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, the above named L. L. Hamilton has contracted with the Board of Education of Church District for the delivery of coal to the several School houses of Church District paying coal for the sum of 17½ cents per bushel.

Now, therefore, if the said L. L. Hamilton

shall faithfully perform the conditions set forth in the contract aforesaid

then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
