

Hundred, W.Va. February 23rd. 1923.

At a meeting of the Board of Education of Church District, duly and regularly held on this the 23rd., day of February 1923, at the regular place of meeting in the Town of Hundred, Church District, Wetzel County, West Virginia:

And the said Board of Education now sitting as a canvassing board on this the 23rd., day of February 1923, it being the fifth day after the date of the Special School Bond election held in said district on the 18th., day of February 1923, having carefully and impartially examined the returns of said special election held for the purpose of authorizing or rejecting the issuance by said Board of Education of 6% bonds of said District in the amount of \$65,000.00 and the laying of the special levies for the redemption of said bonds and the payment of the interest thereon, as provided for in the ordinance or resolution of said Board adopted on the 21st., day of January 1923, the said board sitting as a canvassing board doth hereby ascertain and certify the results of said election to be as follows, viz:

198 votes were cast for said bonds at precinct No. 1 in the town of Hundred in said District.

200 votes were cast for said bonds at precinct No. 2 in the town of Hundred in said District,

34 votes were cast against said bonds at precinct No. 1 in the town of Hundred in said District

30 votes were cast against said bonds at Precinct No. 2 in the town of Hundred in said District,

198 votes were cast for said levies at precinct No. 1 in the town of Hundred in said district

194 votes were cast for said levies at precinct No. 2 in the town of Hundred in said District

24 votes were cast against said levies at Precinct No. 1 in the town of Hundred in said District

21 votes were cast against said levies at Precinct No. 2 in the town of Hundred in said District

And the said Board of Canvassers doth find and hereby certifies that the above named voting precincts and polling places are all of the regularly and legally established voting precincts and polling places in said Church District; and doth also ascertain and find that of the total number of votes, to-wit: 717 cast at said election, more than three-fifths thereof, to-wit: 508 votes were cast in favor of the issuance and sale of said bonds, and 220 votes were cast in favor of the laying of said levies: and the said Board doth therefore, hereby declare that the issuance and sale of said bonds and the laying of the said levies as provided for in said ordinance or resolution etc., of said Board of Education adopted on the 21st day of January 1922, is authorized and approved by more than three-fifths of the voters of said district voting at said election.
