THIS DEED made this 6 day of June, 1936, between the Board of Education of Wetzel County, West Virginia, a corporation, by Leslie Garrett, County Superintendent of Schools of said County, of the first part, and Jacob I. Cook of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the provisions in the deed conveying the hereinafter described property to the District Board of Education of Proctor District, as well as in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty-five (\$155.00) dollars, paid in cash, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part doth grant, sell, and convey unto the said party of the second part the following described lots of land, situate in Proctor District, Wetzel County, West Virginia, on the waters of Little Fleming Creek, bounded and described as follows:

First Lot: Beginning at a stake in field, thence S. 78° E 4-12/35 poles to a stake; thence N. 114° E 2-15/35 poles to a stake; thence N. 78° W 4-12/25 poles to the place of beginning.

Containing 11-461/625 poles. Being the same property conveyed to the Board of Education of Proctor District by deed of G. W. Cook and wife, dated the 24th day of July, 1888, recorded in Deed Book 25, page 525, Wetzel County records.

But there is expressly excepted from the operation of this deed all the rights now vested in the State Road Commission of West Virginia for right-of-way for State Route 7.

Second lot: Beginning at a sycamore on the bank of the run, N. 71° 30' W. 122 feet to a stake, thence, N. 16° 31' E. 132 feet to a stake in the old county road, thence, S. 78° E. 132 feet to a stake on the bank of the run, thence, S. 15° 45' W. 148 feet to the beginning.

Containing 18550 square feet, be the same more or less, being the same property conveyed to the Board of Education of Proctor District, Wetzel County, West Virginia by deed of Jacob I. Cook dated the 14th day of June, 1926, recorded in Deed Book 145, page 203, Wetzel County, West Virginia records.

But it is expressly understood and agreed that the said Board of Education excepts and reserved from the operation of this deed the building now standing on said land with the right to immediately seal and dis-ose and remove said building from said premises.

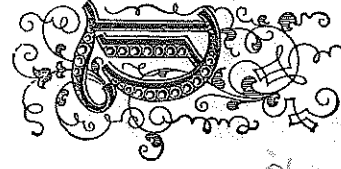
