P. MC DONNELL AND WIFE

This Deed made the 23d day

of October in the year 1878

between P. McDonnell and Bridget  
McDonnell his wife of the County  
of Wetzel and the State of West

Virginia party of the first part  
for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five Dollars to them  
paid by the District Board of Education of the School District of  
Church of the County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged do grant unto the Board of Education of said School  
District of Church the party of the second part and their assigns  
forever the following described parcel of land situated on the  
waters of Fish Creek in the County and State aforesaid and bounded  
as follows to wit: Beginning in P. McDonnell's field at a stone,  
thence S  $70\frac{1}{2}$  E five poles to a stone, thence S  $20\frac{1}{4}$  W. ten poles to  
the center of the County Road, thence with said Road N.  $52\frac{1}{2}$  W. 6  
poles and 17 links to a stone at the upper side of the County  
Road, thence N.  $31\frac{1}{4}$  E. 6 poles to the place of beginning containing  
One third of one acre more or less, together with all the privileges  
and appurtenances thereto belonging and the said party of the first  
part do hereby covenant with the party of the second part that they  
will warrant generally the title to the said property.
