

RIGHT OF WAY FOR A PUBLIC STREET.

We, the BOARD OF EDUCATION OF CHURCH DISTRICT, in consideration of the Council of the Town of Hundred having vacated and closed and dedicated to the use of this Board that part of Sampson Street running from Dewey Street, in the said Town of Hundred to the property of W.J. Devine, we, the said Board of Education of Church District, Wetzel County, West Virginia, do hereby give and grant to the Town of Hundred and the public in general ~~sixteen~~ feet off the south part of our land, running from Sampson Street to Main Street, along the line of W.J. Devine and enough off the south part of our land along the alley running from said Sampson Street to Wetzel Street to make said Alley sixteen foot wide and hereby agree to construct a good curb of concrete along each side of said sixteen feet from Main Street to Sampson Street and fill the same with stone and gravel so as to make a hard surface Street during the Spring and Summer of 1923. And the Council of the said Town of Hundred hereby accepts said sixteen feet and the said portion along the said Alley and dedicate it to the said Town of Hundred and the general public as a Street to be known as School Street. This *24* day of February 1923.
