- f) Assists in proper referrals of individuals to agencies and specialists in the community as appropriate.
- g) Provides appropriate individualized programs of therapy to meet individual students' needs and correct existing speech or language handicaps.
- h) Collaborates with classroom teachers and other school staff members to implement therapy by suggestions for the student's daily activities.
- i) Provides information, support, and counseling to parents and families when appropriate.
- j) Provides in-service education and serves as a consultant to teachers and school staff members on topics concerning speech improvement.
- k) Keeps thorough ongoing records for the individual student receiving therapy or other school-provided speech services.
- l) Maintains lists of referred, screened, and eligible students, as well as a directory of outside agencies, consultants, specialists, and related services.
- m) Assumes primary responsibility for requisitioning and maintaining 'needed equipment and supplies.
- n) Maintains and upgrades his/her professional skills.
