THIS DEED, Made this 5th. day of December, 1921, between Moses Bartrug, widower, of Burton, West Virginia, of the first part, and The Board of Education of Church District, Wetzel County, West Virginia, party of the second part, Witnesseth;

That in consideration of FIFTY DOLLARS, (\$50.) in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said first party hereby grants to said second party the right to use a certain spring of water, situated on the hill side above the present residence of T.W. Robinson, with the right to build reservoir and lay pipe line from said spring to the school house at Burton, W. Va. and the right of ingress and egress to build, maintain and repair same and to haul material in to build, repair and rebuild same as necessary.

First party reserves right to use water from said pipe line for his own use for one house or dwelling. And second party agrees put in Tee for first partys connection at or near school house.
